1. The deadline for photographic submissions is **18 January 2019**.
2. You must provide your full name and contact details as requested within the submission portal when submitting your photographs. If you do not provide contact details, the University will be unable to use your entry.
3. There is no limit on the number of photographs that you can submit.
4. Whilst the Copyright Designs and Patents Act 1988 assigns the copyright of any image to the photographer, by providing a photograph(s) to us you agree to the University publishing the photograph(s) at any of its social mobility events throughout 2019, including at the Opportunity: Captured? Exhibition which will tour a range of high profile venues from February to October 2019.
5. The University will decide which photographs will be used for the Exhibition and/or any other event taking place around social mobility in 2019 and reserves the right to not use any photograph(s) submitted by you.
6. You consent to the University using any photograph you submit for publicity purposes and promotional purposes – promotion may take place through a range of activities included through the University's website and social media channels.
7. You consent to the photograph being available on the University's website and on plasma screens situated around the University to promote social mobility, within any exhibition promoting social mobility whether online or otherwise, as general advertising for any social mobility event, as publicity or as part of events on YouTube or any other University social media platform promoting social mobility,.
8. You consent to the University sharing any photograph submitted, for the purposes of the social mobility events, with any of its partners involved in the events.
9. By submitting any photograph you confirm that you are the owner of the photograph and have obtained the consent of all persons pictured in the photograph where such persons can be identified and are the main focus of the image (including informing them of the reasons why you are taking the photograph).
10. The University reserves the right to cancel any of its social mobility events for any reason.
11. You have the right to withdraw your consent for the above uses at any time. Please note that where a photograph is already being exhibited it may be difficult to remove your photograph, however the University will ensure that it is not used in any further social mobility events and it is either returned or destroyed.
